## Recall of Fromagerie Blanc's raw milk goat cheese products due to possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*

The European Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed has issued a notification on the recall of various Fromagerie Blanc's raw milk goat cheese products due to possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*.

- As the implicated products were imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency has directed the importer, Symphony W&C Pte Ltd, to recall the products. The recall is ongoing.
- *Listeria monocytogenes* is foodborne bacterium that can cause food poisoning. Food that are at higher risk of being contaminated with Listeria include unpasteurised (raw) dairy products, soft cheese including those ripened by mould, refrigerated meat spread, smoked fish and ready-to-eat deli meats and sausages. Symptoms of Listeria infection may include fever, muscle ache, nausea and diarrhoea. Listeria can be fatal to pregnant women, infants and the immunocompromised.
