Advisory on ensuring the safety of food exported from Singapore

It is important to continue assuring our trading partners of the safety of food exported from Singapore during the COVID-19 situation. In this regard, food manufacturers and exporters are reminded to abide by the food safety measures and demonstrate that these preventive measures are in place during food production.

- 2 Keeping all workers in the food production and supply chains healthy and safe is critical to prevent disruptions to food operations in Singapore. SFA has issued <u>guidelines</u>¹ to food establishments in Singapore on the management of sick workers, cleaning and disinfection, use of personal protective equipment, personal hygiene and other safe distancing measures.
- Food manufacturers and exporters are also reminded to implement other measures, such as safe distancing during food processing to protect food workers. The WHO/FAO has issued <u>guidelines</u>² "COVID-19 and food safety: guidance for food businesses" to highlight these additional measures and include examples of practical measures for safe distancing in the food processing environment, staff canteens, transport and delivery.
