**RESUMPTION OF IMPORTS FOR POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS
FOLLOWING LIFTING OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS FOR HPAI IN THE UK**

We are pleased to inform you that restrictions on poultry and poultry products from the following regions in UK is lifted with immediate effect. This is following resolution of High pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI).

- i Near Byker, Newcastle Upon Tyne, Tyne and Wear, England - AIV 2022/12
- ii Near Blaydon, Gateshead, Tyne and Wear, England - AIV 2022/23
- iii Near Strichen, Aberdeenshire, Scotland – AIV 2022/31

2 In order to facilitate the clearance of permits for poultry and poultry products, the following attestations are to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in the United Kingdom
- b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against avian influenza (AI).
- c) The poultry and poultry products were not derived from birds originating from areas within the 10 km radius restricted area around a highly pathogenic avian influenza affected farm.
- d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in the UK, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
