RESUMPTION OF IMPORT OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS FROM DEPARTMENT OF ILE-ET-VILAINE AND MORBIHAN DUE TO LIFTING OF HPAI RESTRICTIONS

We refer to our circular of 31 March 2022 regarding the temporary import restrictions on the importation of poultry and poultry products from the department of Ile-et-Vilaine and Morbihan, France.

2 We are pleased to inform you that the the restrictions on the import of poultry and poultry products from the department of Ile-et-Vilaine and Morbihan, is lifted with immediate effect.

3 In order to facilitate the clearance of permits for poultry and poultry products, we would require the following attestations to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- (a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in France.
- (b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against avian influenza (AI).
- (c) The poultry and poultry products were not derived from birds originating from the department of Charente, Aveyron, Lot-et-Garonne, Haute Vienne, Corrèze, Dordogne, Finistère, Cantal, Lot, Loire Atlantique, Maine et Loire, Deux-Sèvres, Seine-Maritime and Vendée.
- (d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in France, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
