**RESUMPTION OF IMPORT OF POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS FROM LOLLAND MUNICIPALITY DUE TO LIFTING OF HPAI RESTRICTIONS**

We refer to our circular dated 9 January 2023 regarding the temporary import restrictions on the importation of poultry and poultry products from the municipality of Lolland.

2 We are pleased to inform you that the imports of poultry and poultry products from the Lolland municipality, including the 10km surveillance zones established for the affected holding should it extend beyond the border of municipality, may resume with immediate effect.

3 To facilitate the clearance of permits for other poultry and poultry products, the following additional attestations are required to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- (a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in Denmark.
- (b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against avian influenza (AI).
- (c) The poultry meat and meat products were not derived from birds originating from the municipality of Slagelse and Hedensted, including the 10km surveillance zones established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the municipality.
- (d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in Denmark, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
