**RESUMPTION OF IMPORTS FOR POULTRY AND POULTRY PRODUCTS  
FOLLOWING LIFTING OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS FOR HPAI IN THE UNITED  
KINGDOM**

We are pleased to inform you that restrictions on poultry and poultry products from the region in the United Kingdom (UK) below is lifted with immediate effect. This is following resolution of High pathogenicity avian influenza (HPAI).

- i. Near Milford Haven, Pembrokeshire (surveillance zone – 10km) – AIV 2022/70
- ii. Near Lowestoft, East Suffolk, Suffolk) (surveillance zone – 10km) - AIV 2022/84
- iii. Near Goole, East Riding of Yorkshire, Yorkshire) (surveillance zone – 10km) - AIV 2022/146
- iv. Near Cumnock, East Ayrshire) (surveillance zone – 10km) – AIV 2022/183

2 In order to facilitate the clearance of permits for poultry and poultry products, the following attestations are to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in the United Kingdom
- b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against avian influenza (AI).
- c) The poultry and poultry products were not derived from birds originating from areas within the 10 km radius restricted area around a highly pathogenic avian influenza affected farm.
- d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in the UK, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
