LIFTING OF IMPORT RESTRICTION DUE TO RESOLUTION OF HPAI IN MUNICIPALITY OF TØNDER

We refer to our circular dated 28 November 2023 regarding the temporary import restrictions on the importation of poultry and poultry products from the municipality of Tønder, Denmark.

- We are pleased to inform you that the restrictions on the poultry and poultry products from the municipality of Tønder, including the 10km surveillance zones established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the municipality, are lifted with immediate effect.
- 3 In order to facilitate the clearance of permits for poultry and poultry products, we would require the following attestations to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:
 - a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) is a notifiable disease in Denmark.
 - b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against avian influenza (AI).
 - c) The poultry meat and meat products were not derived from birds originating from the municipality of Holbæk, including the 10km surveillance zones established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the municipality.
 - d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in Denmark, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
