H5N8 HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN INFLUENZA IN BACS-KISKUN, HUNGARY

Hungary reported an outbreak of H5N8 highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) in a duck holding in Bacs-Kiskun county, Hungary and four other secondary outbreaks in its close vicinity.

2 In view of the outbreak, the National Parks Board/Animal & Veterinary Service (NParks/AVS) has imposed a temporary restriction on the importation of ornamental birds, poultry and poultry products from Bacs-Kiskun county, Hungary, including the surveillance zone established for the affected holdings, with effect from 25 March 2020.

3 To facilitate the clearance of permits for other poultry and poultry products, the following additional attestations are required to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- (a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) and H5 and H7 low pathogenicity avian influenza (LPAI) are notifiable diseases in Hungary.
- (b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against H5 and H7 subtypes of avian influenza (AI), as defined by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE).
- (c) The poultry meat and meat products were not derived from birds originating from Bacs-Kiskun county, Komarom-Esztergom county and Hajdu-Bihar county, Hungary, including the surveillance zones established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the county border.
- (d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in Hungary, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
