LIFTING OF IMPORT RESTRICTION DUE TO RESOLUTION OF H5N8 HIGHLY PATHOGENIC AVIAN INFLUENZA IN VIBORG MUNICIPALITY, DENMARK

We refer to our circular dated 8 January 2021 regarding the temporary import restrictions on the importation of poultry and poultry products from Viborg municipality, Denmark.

2 We are pleased to inform you that the restriction on the poultry and poultry products from Viborg municipality, including the surveillance zone established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the municipality, is lifted with immediate effect.

3 To facilitate the clearance of permits for other poultry and poultry products, the following additional attestations are required to be included in the veterinary health certificate accompanying the import of poultry and poultry products:

- (a) Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) and H5 and H7 low pathogenicity avian influenza (LPAI) are notifiable diseases in Denmark.
- (b) The birds from which the meat was sourced were not vaccinated against H5 and H7 subtypes of avian influenza (AI), as defined by the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE).
- (c) The poultry meat and meat products were not derived from birds originating from the municipalities of Bornholm, Ringsted, Slagelse, Kalundborg and Langeland, including the 10km surveillance zones established for the affected holdings should it extend beyond the municipality.
- (d) The poultry from which the meat was derived were born, raised, and slaughtered in Denmark, or were legally imported as day old chicks from countries with equivalent poultry health status.
