

Recall of “Huy Fong Sriracha Hot Chilli Sauce”

The Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) has issued a food recall alert on “Huy Fong Sriracha Hot Chilli Sauce” due to lactic acid build up, which may cause certain bottles to bloat and continue to ferment. The build-up of pressure in the bottles may cause them to explode upon opening.

2 As there is import of the implicated product into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency has directed the two importers, TC Import & Export Pte Ltd and Cold Storage (1983) Pte Ltd, to recall the product. Both recalls are ongoing.

3 Consumers who have purchased the affected product may contact their point of purchase for enquiries, and for a refund or exchange of product.
