


Updated media release:

Update on 12 Apr 2022: Further to our media releases on 6 Apr 2022 and 8 Apr 2022, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has extended the recall to include 4 additional Kinder products from Belgium following a new recall alert issued by the Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) due to possible presence of Salmonella.

SFA has directed 5 importers, Kaimay Trading Pte. Ltd., Heinemann Asia Pacific Pte. Ltd., Focus Network Agencies (S) Pte Ltd, Walluco Pte Ltd and Le Petit Depot Pte Ltd to recall the implicated products. The recall is ongoing. Consumers who have consumed the implicated products and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact their point of purchase or importers for enquiries.

Update on 8 Apr 2022: Further to our media release on 6 Apr 2022, SFA has extended the recall to three more Kinder products following a recall alert issued by the Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) due to possible presence of Salmonella.

The affected products are Kinder Mini Eggs (75g), Kinder Egg Hunt Kit (150g) and Kinder Surprise Maxi (100g) from Belgium. We have directed the importers, Redmart Ltd and Le Petit Depot Pte. Ltd., to recall the products. The recall is ongoing. Consumers who have consumed the implicated products and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact the importers for enquiries.

**Recall of Kinder Surprise chocolate from Belgium
due to possible presence of Salmonella**

The Food Safety Authority of Ireland (FSAI) has issued a notification on the recall of some batches of Kinder Surprise chocolate from Belgium due to possible presence of Salmonella.

2 As the implicated products were imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importer, Redmart Ltd, to recall the products. The recall is ongoing.

3 Salmonella is a pathogenic bacterium that should not be present in ready-to-eat food. Salmonella can cause foodborne illnesses including fever, abdominal cramps and diarrhoea. Consumers who have purchased the implicated products are advised not to consume it. Those who have consumed the implicated products and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact the importer for enquiries.
