Recall of "Bellamy's Organic - Organic Brown Rice Pasta Stars" due to excessive levels of arsenic

The Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has detected arsenic in samples of "Bellamy's Organic - Organic Brown Rice Pasta Stars" at levels exceeding the maximum limit for arsenic in baby food¹ as stated in the Singapore Food Regulations.

- 2 SFA has directed the importer, DKSH Marketing Services Pte Ltd, to recall the product. As a precaution, SFA is recalling all batches of the implicated product. The recall is ongoing.
- 3 The level of arsenic detected may cause the product to be unsafe for consumption by infants if there is long-term intake.
- 4 Consumers who have purchased the implicated product should ensure that their infants do not consume them. Consumers may also wish to seek medical advice for infants who feel unwell. Those who have purchased the affected product may contact their point of purchase for enquiries and for exchange of product.
- 5 Details of the product is as follows:

¹ The maximum limit for arsenic in baby food as stated in the Singapore Food Regulations is 0.1ppm. SFA detected arsenic at levels ranging between 0.12 - 0.3ppm in the samples of the product.
