

## Updated media release

<u>Updated 21 Feb 2024:</u> Further to our media release on 16 Feb 2024, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has extended the recall to include an additional ready-to-eat meat charcuterie product (Busseto's Antipasto Classico) from United States due to the possible presence of *Salmonella*.

SFA has directed the importer, Cold Storage Singapore (1983) Pte Ltd, to recall the product. The recall is ongoing.

Consumers who have purchased the implicated product are advised not to consume it. Those who have consumed the implicated product and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact their point of purchase for enquiries.

## Recall of Beretta Antipasto and Beretta Coppa due to possible presence of Salmonella

The U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) has issued a notification on the recall of Beretta Antipasto and Beretta Coppa due to the possible presence of Salmonella.


2. As the implicated products were imported into Singapore, SFA has directed the importer, Indoguna (Singapore) Pte Ltd, to recall the products. The recall is ongoing.
