ENDANGERED SPECIES (IMPORT AND EXPORT) (PROHIBITION OF SALE) NOTIFICATION 2006

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 (3) of the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act 2006, the Minister for National Development hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Endangered Species (Import and Export) (Prohibition of Sale) Notification 2006 and shall come into operation on 1st March 2006.

Prohibition of sale

2. No person shall sell, offer or expose for sale or display to the public the readily recognisable parts and derivatives set out in the second column of the Schedule in respect of the animal specified in the first column thereof.

Cancellation

3. The Endangered Species (Import and Export) (Prohibition of Sale) Notification (N 1) is cancelled.

MAMMALIA

PERISSODACTYLA RHINOCEROTIDAE
All species (Rhinoceros)

Horn, if worked, unworked or simply prepared and any part, powder or waste of such horn. Substantially complete or parts of dead specimens (either in natural form, stuffed, chilled, preserved, dried or otherwise treated).Meat.

CARNIVORA FELIDAE

Panthera tigris (Tiger)

Substantially complete or parts of dead specimens including, but not limited to, teeth, claws, skin, bones (either in natural form or otherwise treated or prepared which may or may not be contained in preparations).Meat.
