Atlantic Supplies and Trading Pte Ltd and its Director fined \$3,500 each for operating an unlicensed cold store

Atlantic Supplies and Trading Pte Ltd was fined \$3,500 by the Court today for operating an unlicensed cold store. Its Director, Ang Yi Cheng, was also fined \$3,500 for failing to prevent the offence from being committed.

In September 2022, Singapore Food Agency (SFA) officers found during an inspection of the company's Buroh Crescent premises that approximately 1585kg of meat and seafood products were stored in an unlicensed cold store. The products, which include chicken and fish, were seized by SFA.

3 Illegal storage of meat and seafood at unlicensed facilities pose a food safety risk. In Singapore, all cold stores for meat and seafood products must be licensed and are required to meet SFA's requirements and food safety standards. These licensed premises are also routinely inspected by SFA to ensure compliance.

Offenders who store meat and/or fish products illegally shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and/or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year.
