## Recall of cheese products from France due to presence of Listeria Monocytogenes

The European Commission Rapid Alert System for Food and Feed (RASFF) has issued a notification that several cheese products from France have recalled due to the presence of Listeria monocytogenes.

- 2 As there is import of the implicated cheese products into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importers to recall the products. The recall is complete.
- 3 Consumers who had purchased the implicated products are advised not to consume it. Those who have consumed these products should seek medical attention if they feel unwell.
