

Recall of "Now Foods" Royal Jelly Capsules due to detection of Metronidazole

The Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has detected the presence of metronidazole in "Now Foods" Royal Jelly Capsules from USA during our inspection and testing of the products.

2 Metronidazole is a globally banned antibiotic in food-producing animals. Under the Singapore Food Regulations, metronidazole is not allowed in food products. As the implicated products were imported into Singapore, SFA has directed the importer, Bloom Concept Pte Ltd, to recall the affected batches. The recall is ongoing.

3 Consumers who have purchased the implicated product are advised not to consume it. Those who have consumed the implicated product and have concerns about their health should seek medical advice. Consumers may contact their point of purchase for enquiries.
