## Recall of Unicorn Classic Camembert due to possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*

The Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) has issued a notification on the recall of Unicorn Classic Camembert due to possible presence of *Listeria monocytogenes*.

- 2 As the implicated product was imported into Singapore, SFA has directed the importer, Xie Chun Trading Pte Ltd, to recall the product. The recall is ongoing.
- *Listeria monocytogenes* is foodborne bacterium that can cause food poisoning. Food that are at higher risk of being contaminated with Listeria include unpasteurised (raw) dairy products, soft cheese including those ripened by mould, refrigerated meat spread, smoked fish and ready-to-eat deli meats and sausages. Symptoms of Listeria infection may include fever, muscle ache, nausea and diarrhoea.
