## Recall of Wilton Rainbow Chip Crunch Sprinkles due to undeclared allergen (milk)

The United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has issued a food recall alert on Wilton Rainbow Chip Crunch Sprinkles due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (milk).

- As the implicated product was imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importer, Phoon Huat Pte Ltd, to recall the product. The recall is ongoing.
- Allergen in food could result in allergic reaction in individuals who are sensitive to it. Under the Sale of Food (Food Regulation), food products containing ingredients that are known to cause hypersensitivity must be declared on food packaging labels to safeguard public health.
- The presence of milk allergen does not pose a food safety issue to consumers at large, except for those who are allergic to milk. Consumers who have purchased the affected product, and who are allergic to milk, should not consume it.
