



Recall of Woolworths Macro Almond, Brazil & Cashew Spread due to presence of undeclared allergen (peanut)

The Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) has issued a food recall alert on Woolworths Macro Almond, Brazil & Cashew Spread due to the presence of an undeclared allergen (peanut).

2 As the implicated product was imported into Singapore, the Singapore Food Agency (SFA) has directed the importer, Ban Choon Marketing Pte Ltd, to recall the product. The recall is ongoing.

3 Allergen in food could result in allergic reaction in individuals who are sensitive to it. Under the Sale of Food (Food Regulation), food products containing ingredients that are known to cause hypersensitivity must be declared on food packaging labels to safeguard public health.

4 The presence of peanut allergen does not pose a food safety issue to consumers at large, except for those who are allergic to peanut. Consumers who have purchased the affected product, and who are allergic to peanut, should not consume it.
